

NDPTC – Instructor Led Training Courses (Pre-approved for CECs for CFMs)

The [National Disaster Preparedness Training Center \(NDPTC\)](#) is a member of the National Domestic Preparedness Consortium (NDPC), which was expanded in 2007 to address all-hazards capabilities by the addition of the University of Hawai'i. The NDPTC is authorized to develop and deliver training and educational programs related to homeland security and disaster management, with a specific focus on natural hazards, coastal communities, and the special needs and opportunities of islands and territories. NDPTC is a mobile training center, so if you are interested in a course and you are a part of an organization that you feel could benefit from our courses we can coordinate with you regarding scheduling a course delivery in your local area at your facility.

COST: Attendees pay **no fee** to attend NDPTC courses; the cost is covered by a cooperative agreement with the Dept. of Homeland Security (DHS) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

LOCATION: NDPTC is a mobile training center, so if you are interested in a course and you are a part of an organization that you feel could benefit from our courses we can coordinate with you regarding scheduling a course delivery in your local area at your facility. To schedule a training NDPTC requests that the hosting agency (agency requesting the course) provide a location for the course delivery, assist with filling the course delivery to meet the 25 participant minimum and to assist with the outreach of the course (NDPTC provides a flyer for distribution). All course delivery requests need to be routed through the State Administrative Agency (SAA)/Training Point of Contact. Please be sure to request approval from the SAA prior to submitting your request. If you are unsure who the SAA in your area is, please contact NDPTC and they can guide you to correct contact to assist with your approval. ELIGIBILITY: Anyone in the community is welcome to register for and attend NDPTC course delivery offerings. NDPTC course deliveries are listed on their website- <https://ndptc.hawaii.edu/training>. If you are interested in a course delivery offering in your local area, please create a NDPTC profile for online registration for the course and complete the online pre-test prior to the course date. In certain cases hosting agencies request courses for a specific group of their choice. If there is a registration code initiated, you can contact NDPTC to request to attend the course and they can forward your request to the hosting agency for decision and approval. If you are not a U.S. Citizen, please contact NDPTC for a Foreign National Visitor Access Request form. This form needs to be completed, processed and approved for participation 30-60 days prior to the NDPTC course delivery. Complete and forward the form to NDPTC at ndptc-trainings@lists.hawaii.edu and they will submit for approval. Once a final decision is received, NDPTC will contact you.

Each of the following NDPTC courses have been pre-approved for CECs. To be eligible to obtain CECs for any of these courses, the CFM must provide certificate of completion and/or successful completion of the course post-test.

NOTE: Courses are eligible for the CECs listed below if the course title, version date, and duration matches those listed below- any variation requires that the course be re-evaluated for credit before CECs can be given.
